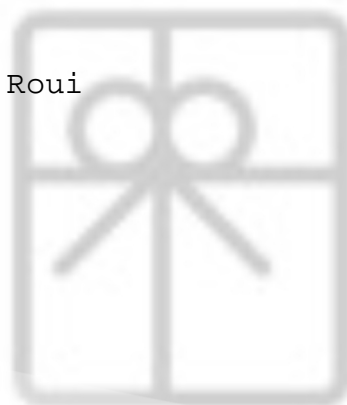


The Garden of Joy
